



The next two graphs below illustrate students' responses to situations where the most apt statistical analysis was independent samples t-lest. Even though they have covered many more statistical tests by Week 10 and thus hai many more possible choices, students have improved in being able to apply this analysis appropriately.



Basic Quantitative Reasoning

Even though this quantitative reasoning test had no statistics content, nor did the course cover these topics explik students improved on average about 7% (SD = 13%), a statistically significant increase, t(47) = 3.57, p = .001.






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In Conclusion
